Aware Start Menu: This is the menu that appears every time you login to Aware. There are 4 tabs: Analyze, Tests, Students and Reports.

Using the Analyze Tab


Most reports are accessed from the Analyze of My Analysis (depending of level of access) tab.

From here you can view reports by:

- Class Schedule Creates a tree that contains all tests taken by your class
- All My Students All students assigned to your academic classes
- My Student Groups Creates a tree that shows all student groups created by you or a campus administrator.




Extra Tip: At the bottom of this screen, there is the option to create a monitor list to monitor custom groups of students. Use help button in upper right hand corner of the screen and choose on monitor groups/lists for more information on this topic.




Click on the group, then the type of test, the subject, the grade level, and then the test.

For comparison of data, you have these options:

- o Color results: 100-90 green; 89-80 yellow; 79-76 orange, 75-0 red
- Color by comparison green-improving, red-declining, yellow-maintaining
- Compare across tests This is great for printing student tutorial strips
- o Compare across groups Very useful for exporting data to Excel

The Student Tab allows you to search for a student and helps you to create/manage your monitor lists.

- You can view a student's testing history by clicking on test tab.
