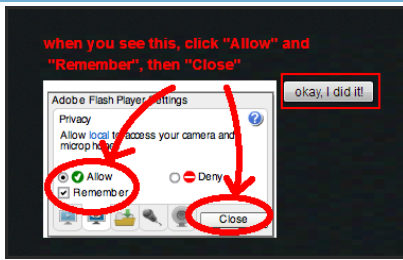


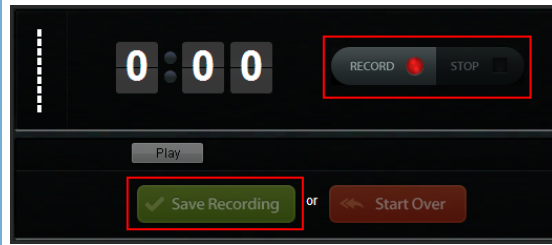
Adobe Flash Player Settings



Recordmp3 is a site that allows you to record audio on the site and gives you a web address where it is saved.

Visit <http://www.recordmp3.org/> and follow the directions on the screen to ensure the Adobe Flash Player settings are set properly.

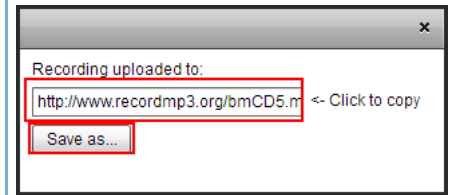
Recording Audio



If you are using a laptop it will have a built-in microphone. A desktop will require a microphone to plug into the computer.

Record your message. Use the **“Play”** button to review the recording. Then choose to **“Save Recording”** if you are happy with the recording or **“Start Over”** to re-record.

Acquiring the Link



After pressing **“Save Recording”** the file will be uploaded to the web. A new window will open that gives you the option to **Save the file** or **copy the link** where the file is saved online. Copy this link to use with a QR creator.

NOTE: If you are recording **multiple audio files**, we have found **you have to close the site and open it again** to start fresh. If you don't, the site stalls out.

Creating the QR Code

There are many sites that you can use to create QR Codes. We have had luck with **QRStuff.com**. It is quick and easy to use.

Open <http://www.qrstuff.com/> and follow these 4 easy steps.



- Data Type:** Choose what type of information you are sharing. In this case you will choose **“Website URL”**.
- Content:** **Paste** the link you copied from Recordmp3.org here.
- Foreground Color:** Choose a color for your QR Code. A preview will appear to the right of this step. **Note: a darker color is better for scanning!**
- Output Type:** **Download** your QR code to use with your activity. Refer to the next page to learn how to print your QR Codes.
